Summer Intern Reimbursement Applications Now Open



The deadline for businesses to submit their internship reimbursement applications for the summer semester is coming up! Applications must be filled out in full and returned by April 26, 2023. Contact the the JSDC office if your business would like to learn more about the application process.

The **Internship Reimbursement Program** is designed to increase the number of local internships and assist employers in workforce recruitment and retention. The Program reimburses employers up to \$3,500 for the payroll costs of university/college students hired as interns. Qualified employers must be in Stutsman County and pay the intern at least \$15/hour.

The 2022 Audit performed by Schauer & Associates has been approved by the Board of Directors. The final version will be presented at the Annual Meeting.

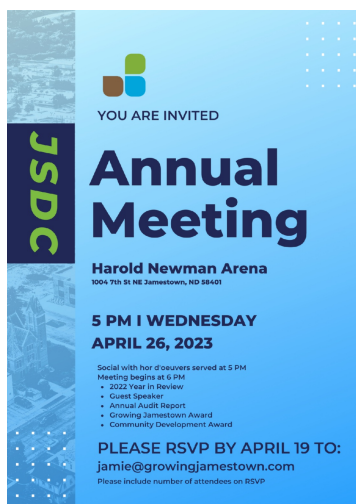
The 2024 Budget prepared by the JSDC Finance Committee was also approved.
