Explorers Academy Expansion Receives JSDC Funding Approval

The Jamestown/Stutsman Development Corporation Board has approved up to \$10,000 in funding for Explorers Academy's childcare expansion, with costs shared 80/20 between the city and county.

The project will boost the facility's capacity from 60 to 90 children, from infants to school-aged kids.

Planned upgrades include new classrooms, additional bathrooms, and improved playground equipment for a more structured layout.

Tyler Liebl of Explorers Academy highlighted the focus on safety, noting 24/7 security cameras and secure access. The expansion will especially benefit schoolaged children while offering flexibility for all age groups. It's also expected to create five full-time and eight to nine part-time jobs.

The funding is contingent upon Explorers Academy submitting detailed receipts corresponding to the expansion project. This approval reflects JSDC's continued support for projects that address critical community needs, particularly in childcare services, where demand continues to grow in the Jamestown area.


JSDC Annual Meeting Set
