Green Bison Soy Processing Plant Ribbon Cutting Held



We were thrilled to be able to celebrate the ribbon cutting of the Green Bison Soy Processing Plant in the Spiritwood Energy Park on Tuesday, November 14th.

Green Bison is a joint venture between ADM and Marathon Petroleum. This plant is the very first dedicated soybean crushing plant and refinery in the state of North Dakota and can process up to 150,000 bushels of soybeans each day.



Breck A Leach, DMD Flex PACE Request Approved

At their November

Meeting, the JSDC Board of Directors voted to approve the Flex PACE request for Breck A Leach, DMD of up to \$71,466.47.

Breck A Leach, DMD is purchasing a building in Jamestown in order to further expand his dental clinic. He is working towards offering additional services not currently available in Jamestown, such as dental implants and sedation dentistry.



Our 5 Sons Flex PACE Request Approved

At their November Meeting, the JSDC Board of Directors voted to approve the Flex PACE request for Our 5 Boys, LLC \$85,714.31. Our 5 Boys, LLC is the real estate holding company for T&K Pediatric Services.

Our 5 Boys, LLC is purchasing a new location in Jamestown. They have outgrown their current facility with the addition of new programs, such as pediatric behavioral health services. The new location will also have a gym where therapy sessions can take place.



ABC Learn-N-Play Daycare Expansion Request Approved

ABC Learn-N-Play Daycare was approved for up to \$10,000 with JSDC's Daycare Expansion Program. This daycare is remodeling its current facility to add an additional accessible restroom to help increase capacity. With this additional restroom, the space can be more inclusive for all children, as well as provide another restroom

for children to use as there is no restroom on the main floor where the children are served.
