Fall Internship Reimbursement Applications Approved

The JSDC Board of Directors approved two internship reimbursement applications for the Fall 2024 semester at their September meeting.



The Internship Reimbursement Program is designed to increase the number of local internships and assist employers in workforce recruitment and retention. The Program reimburses employers up to \$3,500 for the payroll costs of university/college students hired as interns. Qualified employers must be in Stutsman County and pay the intern at least \$15/hour.
