### Jamestown Gymnastics Latest Flex PACE Project

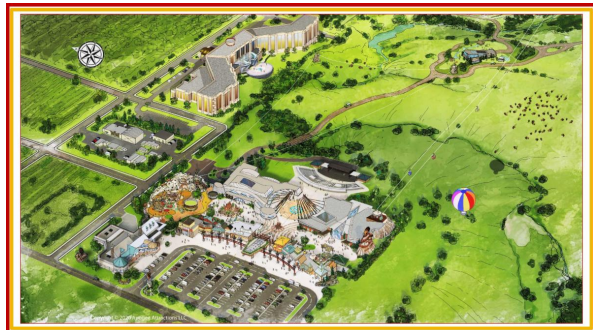


On July 13, the JSDC Board of Directors approved a Flex PACE Interest Buydown Loan to [Jamestown Gymnastic Club](#) for their Raise the Roof Expansion and Remodel Project.

The expansion will include in-ground pits and trampolines, elevated ceiling height for uneven bars, a dedicated preschool area, and enough space for showteam practices, and will allow additional community members the opportunity for movement through gymnastic-like activities.

### Jamestown Tourism / Buffalo City Park

The JSDC Board of Directors approved \$25,000 to [Jamestown Tourism](#) for a market and feasibility assessment for Buffalo City Park. The Park will be a cultural attraction in Jamestown that will highlight the story of the North American Bison and the heritage of North Dakota Industry creating new tax revenue for Jamestown. Searle Swedlund, Executive Director of Jamestown Tourism, reported that to date, independent funds (approximately \$100,000) have been raised by private individuals and businesses to produce concepts for Buffalo City Park.
