Local Incentive Options	Summary	ND Century Code Statute Reference
Business Improvement District (BID)	Allows communities to establish a district in which businesses pay an additional tax in order to fund projects within the district's boundaries. Can be used for planning, beautification, event creation, marketing, etc.	NDCC § 40-22.1
Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILT or PILOT)	Allows communities (fewer than 40,000) to grant a partial or complete property tax exemption for new or expanding retail businesses.	NDCC § 40-57.1-03
Tax Increment Financing (TIF)	Allows communities to establish a program for urban renewal to use public and private resources to address underdeveloped, blighted or underemployed areas.	NDCC § 40-58
